



Recommended PC Board Pattern

 Marking: Top row- Inductance code, Bottom row-YYWW







8. Soldering:

Mildly activated rosin fluxes are preferred. The minimum amount of solder can lead to damage from the stresses caused by the difference in coefficients of expansion between solder, chip and substrate. Our terminations are suitable for all re-flow soldering systems. If hand soldering cannot be avoided, the preferred technique is the utilization of hot air.

8-1 Solder Re-flow:


Recommended temperature profiles for re-flow soldering in Figure 1.

8-2 Soldering Iron (Figure 2):


Products attachment with soldering iron is discouraged due to the inherent process control limitations. In the event that a soldering iron must be employed the following precautions are recommended.

Note:

- a) Preheat circuit and products to 150°C.
- b) 355°C tip temperature (Max.)
- c) Never contact the ceramic with the iron tip
- d) 1.0mm tip diameter (Max.)
- e) Use a 20 watt soldering iron with tip diameter of 1.0mm
- f) Limit soldering time to 4~5 secs.



Reflow times: 3 times max Fig.1




Iron Soldering times: 1 times max





Application Notice:

1. Storage Conditions:
